Day 1: Arriving Bus pickup you from airport to hostel for check in after you arriving Cairns. You can choose to visit **Port Douglas** half day (own expense \$40) if you arrive in the morning or just relax and tour around Cairns city (we supply PDF Cairns city map with marked sightseeing location).

Day 2: Great Barrier Reef 7:45am Walk five minutes to reef fleet terminal. Cruise with "Super Cat" to outer Great Barrier Reef. On arrival in **Kuranda** there is free time to explore the "Village in the Rainforest" and it's many attractions, including the Heritage Markets which operate daily. At the scheduled time, board **Skyrail** for the world's most beautiful rainforest experience. Glide over the Rainforest canopy and take advantage of the two stops enroute to enjoy a walk through the rainforest or visit the CSIRO Interpretive Centre. After enjoying the "World's most beautiful Rainforest Experience", take a short walk to the fascinating **Tjapukai Aboriginal Cultural Park**. When you arrive at Tjapukai, you are on 25 acres of tribal land, where you will get to experience a range of activities with the traditional people of Far North Queensland. You discover this ancient culture through theatres, stage shows and demonstrations before boarding your coach for the return to your accommodation.
